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A revised provisional seniority list of Assistant Executive Engineers of PSC-1992, LR-1993, UK-1990, CERP-1991 batches along with upgraded Assistant Executive Engineers of Zone-VI was communicated duly implementing the Rule 16 (h) of A.P.Sate and Subordinate service rules and repatriation as per G.O.610 vide reference 9th cited in supercession of the earlier provisional seniority lists communicated vide reference 1st and 2nd cited.

In response to the above, certain individuals have filed objections which are discussed and disposed off as follows, duly keeping in view of the court directions and Government Orders.

They have submitted that they have joined service during April 1992 and they were placed on probation, after a long gap of 4 years i.e., in October'1996. In this proceeding we were kept on probation and directed to pass Departmental test in the probation period retrospectively from the date of my appointment. As such it is not possible for any employee to pass the departmental test retrospectively if probation is commenced retrospectively.

They have further submitted that the AEE post is selection post. As per rule 5(a) of Andhra Pradesh State and subordinate rules, all first appointments to a state service and all promotions/appointment by transfer in that service shall be made on grounds of merit and ability. Seniority being considered only where merit and ability are approximately equal, by the appointing authority as specified in sub rule (a) of rule 6 from the panel of candidates and as per AP State and Subordinate service rules, clause 36 (i) clearly indicates that *"in respect of the candidate selected by the APPSC or other selecting authorities by direct recruitment, shall be with reference to their ranking assigned irrespective of the date of commencement of their probation in that category"* which clearly overwrites the provision in clause 16 (h).

With regard to the Inclusion of temporary recruited Asst Executive Engineers such as upgraded, UK & CERP batch Assistant Executive Engineers in the seniority list Panel, they have submitted that giving the dual benefit to the temporary Assistant Executive Engineers i.e, service benefit and seniority benefit is causing much hardship in terms of loss of seniority to the directly recruited Assistant Executive Engineers due to application of 16(H). As per the seniority list, direct recruited Assistant Executive Engineers whose probation was declared prior to regularization of temporary Assistant Executive Engineers are placed below the panel which is incorrect.

In view of the above reasons they have submitted that modifying their position in the initial cadre of AEE at this juncture after a long gap of 22 years is not justified in disturbing our APPSC seniority rank. Hence seniority can't be altered at this stage. Thus viewing from any angle, their APPSC seniority shall not be altered and the penal clause 24(c)/16(h) shall not be applied in our case as per the merits in their case.

Remarks:-

As per rule 5 (a) of APSSS rules, all first appointments to a State Service and all promotions/appointments by transfer in that service shall be made on grounds of merit and ability, seniority being considered only where merit and ability are approximately equal, by the appointing authority as specified in sub-rule (a) of 6 from the panel of candidates. Such panel shall be prepared as laid down in rule 6 by the appointing authority or any other authority empowered in this behalf. The rule 6 is pertains to Method of preparation of panels and as per sub-rule (a) of this rule, The panel of approved candidates referred to in sub-rule (a) of rule 5 shall be prepared by the appointing authority or any other authority empowered in this behalf, in consultation with the DPC in respect of post outside the purview of the APPSC and Screening Committee in respect of the posts within the purview of APPSC to recommend the names to the commission. The appointing authority shall make appointments of candidates from such panel/list, in order in which the candidates in such panel are arranged in their order of preference. The rule 36 (i) is pertains to the inter-se seniority where the dates of commencement of probation are same and said rule can not overwrite the provision in clause 16(h)

The Hon'ble High Court of Andhra Pradesh has passed final Orders on 18.12.2008 in WP No.22978/2008 & Batch for implementation of Rule 16 (h) of A.P State and Subordinate Service Rules 1996. Similar orders were also passed by the Hon'ble APAT on 27.02.2009 in OA No.10934/08 & Batch. The Govt. have also issued instructions from time to time to implement Rule 16(h) and also prepare the seniority strictly in accordance with said rule and review the promotions on the revised seniority lists. Accordingly, the seniority is revised and communicated in terms of rule 16(h) of APSSS Rules. An individual on his entering into the service is expected to know the rules of the Dept. and it is need not to mention in the appointment order.

The Hon'ble APAT in their orders dated.03.12.2003 in OA No. 8080/1997 has set aside the G.O.Ms.No.186, PR & RD Dept., dated. 08.04.1996 and stated that it does not take away the rights of the persons, who already passed the tests and got qualified. So, necessarily those, who do not passed the tests within the time, which were given relaxation, have to be considered next to the persons, who have already passed the tests within the prescribed time. It only confers a right on them that they should not be discharged from service and not to confer a right to declare probation from the date of their regular recruitment for not passing the tests, within the time. Accordingly, commencement of probation of the Assistant Executive Engineers who passed account test belatedly have been revised as per rule 16 (h) of A.P.State and Subordiante Service Rules and with reference to the said revised date, their names has been placed in the revised provisional seniority list of Assistant Executive Engineers of Zone VI.

Regarding Placement of Temporary Assistant Executive Engineers appointed under UK and CERP during the year 1990 and 1991 respectively, it is informed that the Government have issued orders for regularization of the services of the Temporary Assistant Executive Engineers appointed during the years 1990-95 after last regular candidate vide G.O.Ms.No.234, PR&RD (Estt.III) Department, dated27.06.2005 and later Government have issued orders in respect of Temporary AEEs appointed during the year 1990-93 for regularization of their services below the last regular candidate prior to promulgation of Act 2/94 vide G.O.Ms.No.262, PR&RD (Estt.III) Department, dated.17.06.2006. Accordingly the services of temporary Assistant Executive Engineers of UK 1990 and CERP 1991 have been regularized below the last regular candidate before promulgation of Act 2/94 w.e.f.08.05.1993, i.e., below APPSC LR-1993 Assistant Executive Engineers.

As per the Hon'ble Courts orders and Government directions time to time, the commencement of probation of the Assistant Executive Engineers of APPSC 1992, LR 93, UK-90 and CERP-91 batches are reviewed as per penal clause 16 (h) of A.P.State and Subordinate Service Rules and accordingly the commencement of probation and Declaration of probation of Assistant Executive Engineers who do not pass account test within their probation period have been revised with reference to the date of passing of account test and placed them in the seniority list with reference to the said revised date.

It is further informed that the rule 16 (h) will be applied only to the Assistant Executive Engineers who do not pass the account test within the probation period, but not others next to them in the list before applying 16 (h).

Hence, their objections are rejected.

They were appointed as Assistant Executive Engineers through APPSC during 1992. Revised Provisional seniority of Assistant Executive Engineers of PSC-92, LR-93, UK-90, CERP-91 batches along with upgraded AEEs of Zone VI was communicated through PRED Website for objections and in this seniority list our names were shown at Sl.Nos.183, 205, 208, 228 & 229 and submit herewith the following few lines for kind consideration and favorable orders.

a) Objection against Sri.K.Shyamsunder at SI.No.180 and Smt.K.Vinatha at SI.No.181:

The Hon'ble Tribunal has set aside the G.O.Rt.No.1583, dt.04.10.2001 and G.O.Rt.No.1584, dt.04.10.2001. As such they have approached the Hon'ble High Court of AP, Hyderabad and the issue is still pending. Therefore it is understood that there are neither any orders from the Hon'ble High Court nor any consequential memos issued by the ENC, PR, Hyderabad. As such their names should not be placed according to the G.Os, but should be placed according to the orders of the Hon'ble Tribunal. If their names are placed at SI.Nos.180 and 181 for any other reasons not mentioned in the provisional seniority list i.e, "the issue is pending in the Hon'ble Court" it would be believed as hiding the facts and doing undue favour to the above individuals affecting the entire APPSC batch of 1992. Therefore, they have requested that the names of the above individuals may be placed according to the orders of the Hon'ble Tribunal, dated.09.09.2003.

b) Objection against Sri.S.Bhasker Rao at SI.No.182:

They have submitted that, they have already submitted their objection to consider Sri.S.Bhaskar Rao for up-gradation of services to the post of Assistant Executive Engineer with effect from 27-03-1992 (i.e the next date of his joining as Assistant Engineer in PRED). But, his name has been shown above to them at SI.No.182. Hence, once again, they have submitted their objection against the said individual as follows.

As per G.O.Ms No 662 of PR&RD (Estt-III) Dept Dt 24-11-1987, "no Assistant Engineer shall ordinarily be eligible for appointment as Assistant Executive Engineer by transfer(up-gradation) unless he has put in a minimum service of (3) years of service. In the instant case the individual has absorbed in PRED as Assistant Engineer on 26-03-1992 and he has not put up any service in the cadre of Assistant Engineer in PRED. Hence he is not eligible/right for appointment by transfer as Assistant Executive Engineer without completion of minimum service of (3) years of service as Assistant Engineer in PRED.

Further as per rule 33(A) of AP State and Sub-Ordinate service rules, the seniority of a person is to be determined by date of his first appointment to such service and it shall not affect the inter- seniority. Therefore the services of the individual shall not be upgraded as AEE with effect from 27-03-1992 i.e next date of absorption in PRED as Assistant Engineer and he shall be upgraded after completion of minimum service of (3) years as Assistant Engineer in PRED i.e after 26-03-1995 as per his eligibility only.

Further, they have submitted that the seniority list communicated was to be prepared prior to the bifurcation of the RWS&S Department from the PR department and the RWS&S department should follow the same seniority for 3 years from the date of bifurcation. At the time of bifurcation, the individual is not an AEE. Hence, he should not find any place in the seniority list of AEEs finalized by the PR Department. As the upgradation of the services of the individual is done by the RWS&S Department, it is the look after of the ENC, RWS&S to decide the seniority of the individual.

Therefore, they have requested the Engineer- in- Chief (PR) Hyderabad to issue necessary orders to place the above individual in the appropriate place in the seniority list of the AEE of Zone VI duly protecting the seniority of the 120 AEEs of the APPSC 1992 batch.

Remarks:-

a) It is submitted that The Government vide G.O.Rt.No.1583 & 1584, PR & RD (Estt.III) Department, dated.04.10.2001 have permitted the ENC, PR to allow the benefit of appointing Sri.K.Shyamsunder, AE, PR and Smt.M.Vinatha, AE PR by transfer as AEE with effect from 15.03.1992 and 23.03.1992 in terms of G.O.Ms.No.662, PR&RD, dated.24.11.1987. Accordingly, they have been appointed by transfer as AEE w.e.f.15.03.1992 and 23.03.1992 respectively.

It is informed that they have approached the Hon'ble High Court of Andhra Pradesh against the orders of the Hon'ble Tribunal and the Hon'ble High Court passed interim orders of status quo with regard to their position.

As the issue is pending in the Hon'ble Court, their names have been placed in the seniority list with reference to their date of appointment by transfer as AEE i.e., 15.03.1992 and 23.03.1992 respectively subject to outcome of the W.Ps. pending in the Hon'ble Courts. As such there is no hiding of facts and nothing done undue favour to the individuals.

In view of the above, their objections are rejected

b) Sri.S.Bhasker Rao was joined in the department on 26.03.1992 on his transfer from Ground Water Department and during bifurcation, he opted for RWS&S department and at present he is working as DEE in RWS&S department. His name was communicated in the provisional seniority list communicated vide this office Memo., dated.26.09.2008 by placing him with reference to the date of up-gradation i.e., 28.09.1993.

Sri.S.Bhasker Rao, AE had represented to upgrade his services to the post of AEE w.e.f.27.03.1992, i.e., the next date of joining as AE in PRED without weightage on par with Sri.Ch.Sudhakar and Sri.K.Srinivasa Rao who were similarly absorbed in PRED from Ground Water Department and as per amended provisions contained in G.O.662, dated.24.11.1987. But the Government have rejected the said request vide Govt Memo No.18812/Estt.III/A2/2006-3, dt.01.03.2007, since it is not feasible of compliance in view of the orders of the Tribunal in its judgment dt.07.10.2005 in OA No.8350/1998. Aggrieved by the orders of the Government, he has approached the Hon'ble Tribunal in OA No.5774/2007. The Hon'ble Tribunal in its orders, dated.10.04.2008 in OA No.5774/2007, while setting aside the Government orders, dated.01.03.2007, directed the Government to extend the benefit which was extended to the similarly placed persons as the applicant is not seeking weightage which has been struck down in the orders passed in OA No.8350/1998, dated.07.10.2005.

Government vide G.O.Rt.No.1056, dated.21.07.2009, have issued orders extending the benefit of up-gradation of services to the post of AEE w.e.f.27.03.1992 i.e., the next date of joining in PRED, to Sri.S.Bhasker Rao on par with Sri.Ch.Sudhakar and Sri.K.Srinivasa Rao, in relaxation of rule 33 (a) of A.P.State and Subordinate Service Rules, 1996 and subject to finalization of the court cases pending before the Hon'ble High Court and Supreme Court., duly following the procedure of giving notices to the effected persons, if any, in the matter and directed the ENC, RWS&S, Hyderabad to take necessary further action in the matter, accordingly.

Government have issued orders duly relaxing the rule 33 (a) of A.P.State and Subordinate service rules and his name has been placed in the revised provisional seniority list with reference to the date of upgradation given by the Government only. This issue is pending since 2006 i.e., before bifurcation of the department and the date of upgradation is in the united department.

Since there is no case pending in any court against the upgradation of Sri.S.Bhasker Rao w.e.f.27.03.1992 and keeping in view of all the objections received from the Engineers concerned, the matter is referred to Government to take a stand on two other similar situated candidates of Zone-V and the present seniority will continue, till Government takes a different decision in the matter.

In view of the above, their objections are rejected subject to receipt of Government orders.

C) Sri.K.B.Venkateswara Rao, DEE PR O/o the SE, PR, Rangareddy:-

He has submitted that he has completed my M.Tech in JNTU in the year 1999 as per the certificate enclosed and the ENC, PR, Hyderabad sanctioned two advance increments for acquiring higher qualification vide Procgs No.D.VI(1)/36423/1996, dated.23.12.1999.

Remarks:-

As per the certificate submitted by the DEE, he passed the M.Tech (Water Resources Engineering) examination held during December 1998 in Second Class from JNTU, Hyderabad.

In view of the above, M.Tech qualification with month and year of exam held i.e., 12/1998 is indicated against his name in the seniority list.

D) Sri.D.Chiranjeeva Chari, DEE, PR on Deputation with HMDA:-

1. In the provisional seniority list, his date of passing of account test is mentioned as 30.04.1998 as against November 1995, he has passed and he has enclosed an attested copy of the Udyoga Samacharam test results for the same, which has his name, department and place of work.

2. In the provisional seniority list, his date of commencement of probation mentioned as 01.05.1996 which is contrast with Procgs No.DVI(1)/22447/2000-1, dated.11.12.2000 of the ENC, PR.

3. In the provisional seniority list, his qualification mentioned as B.Tech Civil as against Master Degree in Transportation Planning for which I am enclosing an attested copy of his Masters Degree certificate and which is also recorded in his service Register. With the above wrong entries in the provisional seniority list his place of seniority is severely affected, displacing him well below the deserved level.

In view of the above, he has requested to consider his request and claim sympathetically and place him position of the seniority accordingly.

Remarks:-

Regarding passing of account test and placing in the seniority list, it is informed that as per the entry in the service book at Page No.16 of Volume-I, he passed account test for PWD officers & subordinates held on 19.12.1997 and results published on 30.04.1998. Based on the service book entry, necessary proposals were submitted to Government for revised orders of commencement of probation as per rule 16 (h), as he passed account test belatedly. Accordingly, his commencement of probation has been revised to 01.05.1996 (Actual date of commencement of probation is 20.03.1993) with reference to the date of passing of account test.

As per results sheet issued by the APPSC and Xerox copy of udyoga samacharam for November 1995, he passed account test for PWD officers & Subordinates held on 17.11.1995 with Register No.300838 and the said results were published by APPSC on 30.01.1996 which is within his probation period and he could not come under belated passing of account test.

In view of the above, his name is included in the seniority list by placing him at appropriate place based on the order of the APPSC list i.e., below Sri.Mir Hameed Ali and above Sri.V.Raghupathi.

Regarding qualification, it is informed that as per the Xerox copy of the certificate furnished by the individual, he passed Master of Planning with specialization in Transportation Planning during March 1993 from School of Planning and Architecture, New Delhi which is a Deemed University.

A decision will be taken in the matter only after obtaining information from the University whether it is genuine and it is equivalent to M.Tech.

E) Smt.M.Karuna, DEE, PR:-

She has submitted that her qualification in the seniority list communicated in this office Memo dated.10.01.2014 is BE civil, whereas her qualification is ME. The same is entered in her service register also. Copy of the 1st page of her SR is also enclosed for ready reference.

Remarks:-

As per the entry in her service register, she has passed ME Civil engineering with specialization of Structural Engineering of Bharathia Univeristy in February 1992.

In view of the above, the ME Civil qualification is indicated against her name in the seniority list.

F) Sri.D.Gangadhar, DEE, PIU SD, Sangareddy:-

He, at Sl.No.243 in the seniority list of AEEs of Zone VI submit that in the qualification column, it is entered as B.Tech Civil. He has obtained higher qualification i.e., M.Tech (Environmental Engineering) in the month of October 1993 from JNTU, Hyderabad which has been entered vide page 9 in his service register.

Hence, he has requested to change qualification from B.Tech Civil to M.Tech (Env.Engg) 10/1993 in the prescribed column against my name.

Remarks:-

As per the copy of the Certificate and copy of 9th page of service register submitted by him, he passed M.Tech Civil in Environmental Engineering in the month of October 1993 from JNTU, Hyderabad.

In view of the above, the M.Tech Civil qualification in Environmental Engineering with month and year of exam held i.e., 10/1993 is indicated against his name in the seniority list.

G) Sri.S.Sanjeeva Reddy, DEE, PRI SD, Chevella:-

He is working as DEE PRI SD, Chevella, Rangareddy district. There are two anomalies passing of Account test and M.Tech (M) against his name to be corrected. He joined as AEE on 06.05.1992 selected through APPSC 1992. He got promotion as DEE on 22.08.2004 (Copy enclosed). He passed departmental account test held during May 1994 with register No.M370872 (copy enclosed). He has passed his post graduation (M.Tech) in civil Engineering from REC Warangal during September 1989 (Copy enclosed).

Therefore, He has requested the ENC, PR to kindly rectify the above anomalies against his name in the provisional seniority list.

Remarks:-

While communicating the provisional seniority list of AEEs of Zone VI vide this office Memo., dated.10.01.2014, based on the available records, his name has been deleted from the list due to not passing of the account test.

But as per the Xerox copy of the pass certificate issued by the APPSC, he passed account test for PWD officers & Subordinates held on 20.05.1994 and the date of publication of results is 01.08.1994, which is within his probation period, as his actual commencement of probation is 17.03.1993.

Regarding, M.Tech qualification, it is submitted that as per the available records, M.Tech (M) has been shown against his name in the provisional seniority list, dated.10.01.2014, but as per the copy of provisional pass certificate submitted by him and PSC allotment list, he passed M.Tech Civil in Transportation Engineering from the REC, Warangal of Kakatiya University held during September 1989.

In view of the above, his name is included in the seniority list by placing him at appropriate place based on the order of the APPSC list i.e., below Sri.P.Karunasagar and above Sri.K.K.Durga Prasad and M.Tech Civil (Transportation Engineering) is shown against his name in the list.

H) Sri.N.Venkateswarlu, DEE, PIU SD, Bhongir:-

He submitted that his date of commencement of probation has been revised as per rule 16(h) and his name is not included in the provisional seniority list communicated stating that he has passed account test belatedly.

In this connection, he has submitted that he was appointed as AEE through APPSC 1992 batch and joined in the department on 30.04.1992 and his services were regularized w.e.f.17.03.1993. He has passed account test for PWD officers and Subordinates within his probation period on 15.06.1992 (Pass certificate issued by APPSC is enclosed) and entered in Page No.9 of his service register (copy enclosed).

But as seen from provisional seniority list, dated.10.01.2014, his date of passing of account test has been taken as 31.01.1999 which is the passing date of account test for Executive Officers.

Hence, he has requested to restore his seniority with respect to original regularization w.e.f.17.03.1993 and place him below Sri.N.Seetharam Reddy and above Sri.M.Anjaneyulu taking into consideration my date of passing of account for PWD officers and Subordinates on 15.06.1992.

Remarks:-

As verified the available records, it is observed that while communicating the provisional seniority list, dated.10.01.2014, the date of passing of account test taken into consideration is the date of passing of account test for Executive Officers. Accordingly, his date of commencement of probation has been revised as 01.05.1996 duly taking the date of passing of account test as 30.04.1998 and as such, his name is deleted from list and shown in the Memo., dated.10.01.1994, as he could not found place in the list due to belated passing of account test.

But as seen from the copy of the pass certificate issued by the APPSC and entry made in the service register, he passed account test for PWD officers and Subordinates held on 15.06.1992 and the date of publication of results by APPSC is 02.09.1992, which is within his probation period, as his actual date of regularization is 17.03.1993.

In view of the above, his name is included in the seniority list by placing him at appropriate place based on the order of the APPSC list i.e., below Sri.N.Seetharam Reddy and above Sri.M.Anjaneyulu.

I) C.Venkateswar Reddy, AEE, PR MP, Papannapet of Medak:-

He has submitted that the revised provisional seniority list of AEEs of Zone VI was communicated and his name was deleted from the said list due to not passing of account test.

In this connection, he has submitted that the SE, PR, Medak has submitted proposals for exemption from passing of account test as he has crossed 45 years of age as on 23.08.2008.

Therefore, He has requested to kindly issue orders from passing account test and also to enter his name in the seniority list.

Remarks:-

It is submitted that he has not passed account test till to date and more over his services are not yet regularized.

Now, the seniority list is communicated duly implementing the rule 16 (h) strictly in respect of all Engineering personnel.

In view of the above, his objection is rejected.
