We wish to bring to kind notice that in the State Executive Committee meeting held on 15.02.2015 at Tanuku of W.G District, it was unanimously resolved that work load for all Engineers should be equally distributed for better performance of Human resources of the Department.

It was felt that, at present in most of the PIU divisions and Sub-Divisions the work load is very less when compare to that of PRI divisions and Sub-Divisions. As a result of this the Engineers working in the PRI divisions are over burdened and their counterpart have very less work to do.

The impact of this improper distribution of work load causes slow progress of works, reducing the targeted expenditure, which adversely affects the release of grants from the Government of India and other Agencies. It has to be mentioned that, optimum utilization of Human Resources is only justifies the expenditure on administration.

In this connection we have to mention that the previous instructions by the Engineer-in-Chief, PR to all the Superintending Engineers, PR on distribution of work load were not implemented in its true spirit for various reasons.

Hence, we request that necessary proposals may be furnished to the Government of Andhra Pradesh for merging the PIU Units with that of PRI units at all levels to facilitate equal distribution of work load among all Engineers.
